statistical package for social sciences spss software and results were summarized and presented using table and charts the findings of the study showed that an increase in community participation has a greater impact on the increased project sustainability beyond donor support hence community participation is critical determinant of project sustainability beyond donor support it is imperative to take cognizant of the fact that communities today should no longer be seen as recipients of development programmes rather they have become critical stakeholders that have an important role to play in the management of programmes and projects in their areas
